SUDDEN DEATH OF MISS KATIE ALLEN

People were shocked Sunday morning when the news was spread that Miss Katie Allen had died during the night. As she had not arisen at a late hour in the morning her mother went to call her and found her lifeless body in bed as she had slept. Dr. Phifer was immediately summoned but found that life had been extinct for several hours.

Funeral services were held Thursday afternoon from the Congregational church, Rev. A.T. Evans officiating.

The Rebekah Lodge, of which Miss Allen was a member, were present in a body and gave their ritualistic funeral services at the grave.

Miss Allen was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. A.C. Allen, who have lived in Wheatland since 1895. She was born in Hays City, Kansas, May 28, 1884. For the past eight years she has been engaged in photography and was well known throughout the county. Since early childhood she had been afflicted in health, hence her early death was not wholly unexpected. She had been a devoted Christian girl since 12 years of age and a member of the Congregational church. Her exemplary life and character won for her the high regard of all who knew her. The sympathy of all is extended to the aged father and mother and to the three brothers who are left to mourn her departure.
