

BOOKOUT, EDITH VIRGIE BAKER

June 19, 1890-December 4, 1984

Services for Edith Virgie Bookout, 94 who died in Wheatland Dec. 4, were held at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel in Wheatland at 2 p.m. Dec. 7 with the Reverend Floyd Hopper officiating.

Bookout was born in Swan, Mo. June 19, 1890, the daughter of Robert and Rosetta Baker. In 1905 she moved with her family to Wheatland. Shortly thereafter they moved to Washington for a time, returning to homestead in Albany Co. along the Laramie river.

They moved into Wheatland where her husband worked as a road contractor until 1946, at which time they returned to the homestead. After her husband's death in 1955 she moved to Wheatland where she remained until her death.

She was a member of the Golden Age Club.

Survivors include three sons: Cecil, James and Joe Bookout, all of Wheatland; two daughters; Marjorie Powell of Umatilla, Or.; and Virginia White of Wheatland; a sister Beulah Perry of Kaysville, Utah; 12 grandchildren; 27 great-grandchildren and 8 great-great-grandchildren.

Besides her husband she was preceded in death by 5 brothers, 3 sisters, and a son.
