

BORTHWICK, WILLIAM DEAN
July 24, 1952-November 18, 1977

Funeral services were held Monday, November 21, 1977 for William Dean Borthwick at the United Church of Christ with Rev. Sidney A. Hoadley and Rev. T. Robert Engram officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Borthwick 25, was killed Friday, November 18, 1977 in an automobile accident near Little Bear.

He was born July 24, 1952 in Wheatland, and graduated from high school here. While in high school, he excelled in athletics and was selected for the All State Football team. He was also elected to attend Boys State. Upon graduation from high school, he attended the University of Wyoming majoring in Business Administration. At the time of his death, he was the owner/operator of Ben's Bar. He was a member of the All Saints Episcopal Church.

He is survived by his mother, LaVerne Borthwick and his grandmother, Mrs. Helen Borthwick both of Wheatland; and aunt and uncle, Dean and Merrilyn Borthwick of Cheyenne; and cousins, Marcie, Nancy and Mimi Borthwick.

He was preceded in death by his father, Donald Borthwick, in 1972, and his brother, Jerry Dean Borthwick in 1973.

Chuck King, Rich Lewis, Gary Day, Scott Jones, Butch Orr, Danny Davis, John Hamrick, and Richard Cozad served as pallbearers. Schrader-Prell Funeral Home was in charge of the arrangements.
