

BOWMAN, ELIZABETH KISSEL
December 31, 1895-April 11, 1987

Services for Elizabeth Bowman, 91, who died April 11, 1987 in Wheatland, will be Tuesday at 2:30 p.m. at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel, with the Rev. Virgil Lamm officiating.

She was born Dec. 31, 1895 in Rulo, Neb. The family moved to Wyoming to homestead in the Dwyer area.

She and Joseph Bowman were married in 1916 and they operated her husband's family homestead, which is still in the family and being operated by her son.

She was a member of the First Christian church and a charter member of the Dwyer Homemakers Club.

Survivors are two sons, George and Earl Bowman, both of Wheatland; three daughters, Jessie Ennis of Wheatland, Louise Tittle of Fort Laramie and Betty Winkler of Caldwell, Idaho; a brother, Hiram Kissell and a sister, Anne O'Brien, both of Wheatland; 13 grandchildren and 29 great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband in 1948; one son, Joseph; four brothers and two sisters.
