

# Pioneer Jeweler Dies at Wheatland

Wheatland, Wyo., June 24—(U.P.)  
—A pioneer Wyoming jeweler, Charles G. Buechner, 78, died at his home Wednesday afternoon after a long illness.

Prior to his retirement in 1946, Buechner had operated the Buechner drug and jewelry store here for 38 years. He served as mayor of Wheatland for a year from May 1933 to May 1934, and was city clerk from 1912 to 1927.

Before moving to Wheatland in 1908, Buechner helped his father operate the Buechner & Sons jewelry store in Cheyenne. He came to Wyoming with his parents in 1877, one year after he was born in Newark, N. J.

He was a member of the Wheatland Episcopal church and Masonic lodge and of the Cheyenne Elks and Lions clubs.

He is survived by his wife, one daughter, Helen, and one sister. Funeral arrangements have not been announced.
