

MADDOX, EDWIN
1872-August, 1823

Wheatland lost one of its well-known and respected citizens with the passing of Edwin Maddox to his final rest Sunday afternoon.

Mr. Maddox had been suffering with a lingering illness for a long time and the end was not unexpected. The deceased was born in Ohio in 1872, moving from that state to Iowa with his parents at the age of four years. He afterwards resided in Missouri and Nebraska. His last four and one half years were spent in Wheatland.

As a young man, he embraced the Christian faith, and his interest in religious work deepened in later years. He leaves his wife and five children, Eva, Vernon, Nina, Opal and Blanche, all of whom were with him at the time of his death. The sympathy of the community is extended to the bereaved family.

The funeral was held Wednesday afternoon from the Methodist church, Mrs. E.L. Butler conducting the services.
