

MALLERY, MYRTLE MARY SEARL

February 16, 1895-March 10, 1966

Mary Myrtle Mallery, a Wheatland resident from 1909 to 1913, succumbed suddenly at a Ft. Morgan, Colo. Hospital on March 10, 1966. She was born in Casey, Ia. Feb. 16, 1895. After graduating from Wheatland high school, she made her home in Sioux City, Ia. until 1954 when she moved to Ft. Morgan. Mrs. Mallery was a member of the Christian church.
