

MARKER, VIOLA MILDRED RISHCHLING

March 29, 1910-May 18, 1989

Funeral services for Viola Mildred Marker, 79, were held Monday, May 22, 1989, at 2:30 p.m. in All Saints Episcopal Church with Pastor Delbert Dick officiating. A Memorial Eucharist was held in the church at 7:30 Sunday evening with Father Kale King officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Marker died May 18, 1989, in Cheyenne.

Viola Mildred Marker was born March 29, 1910, in Milligan, Neb., the daughter of Henry and Albine (Korbelik) Rischling. She was reared and educated in Nebraska.

She and Arch Marker were married in Nebraska May 7, 1930. In 1936 they moved to Wheatland where she lived until the time of her death. Her husband, who passed away in 1972, was a mechanic for White's.

She was an honorary member of All Saints Episcopal Guild.

She is survived by sons Richard Marker of Wheatland and Ronald Marker of Fort Wayne, Ind., sisters Ruby Belemecich of Sonora, Calif., and Beatrice Vavra of Milligan, eight grandchildren and seven great grandchildren. Besides her husband she was preceded in death by her parents and a sister.
