

MARKS, ARTHUR FRED  
February 6, 1887-May 9, 1945

Funeral services were held Sunday at 2:30 p.m. at the Schrader chapel for Arthur Marks, a former Wheatland resident who died in Thermopolis Wednesday, May 9, following a four-day illness. Mr. James Cameron officiated at the services.

Arthur Fred Marks was born in Madison, Wisc. on February 6, 1887. In 1915 he came to this community and settled south of Wheatland where he resided until 9 years ago when he moved to Thermopolis.

He is survived by three daughters, Mrs. John Roberts of Prairie City, Ore., and Mrs. Clarence Trump and Miss Ruth Marks of Wheatland; three sons, Arthur R. and Roger A. of Wheatland and Fred of the U.S. navy; a sister, Mrs. E.A. Dettmann of Appleton, Wisc.; and 9 grandchildren.
