Funeral For Moses Warren To Be Held This Afternoon

Moses Samuel Warren, a resident of Platte county for the past 28 years, passed to his great reward Saturday, January 28, at the age of 82 years and seven months. Funeral services will be held at two o'clock this afternoon from the Copley funeral chapel with Rev. Noyce officiating.

Mr. Warren was born June 10, 1855 in Green County, Kentucky. At the age of 23 he was united in marriage to Nancy Lee Underwood, and to them were born nine children, three of whom, Harvey, Mary and Lee, preceded him in death. Mr. Warren moved his family to Indiana where they resided until 1900, going then to Oklahoma where the home was made until 1910 when they came into the northwest and settled on a homestead a few miles from Slater. There the home was made until in 1929 they moved to the Wheatland Flats where they have since resided.

He leaves to mourn his death his wife, one daughter, Minnie Macomber of Greeley, Colo.; five sons, Henry of Outlook, Washington; Tom of Cheyenne; Arvie of Thermopolis; and William and Charles of Wheatland. Also surviving him are 26 grandchildren and 11 great grandchildren.

Early in life Mr. Warren became a member of the Baptist church, and remained a faithful Christian, true to the faith throughout the years.
