**Last Rites for Mrs. A. Earhart Held Last Monday**

Mrs. Anna L. Earhart, 82, a Wheatland resident since 1915, died December 2 of an extended illness. Born November 4, 1866, she was a native of Boone, Ia. A niece, Mrs. T.G. Hill of Des Moines, Ia. is the only survivor.

Funeral services for the deceased were held Monday at 2 p.m. in the Schrader chapel with the Rev. J.B. Milstead conducting the services. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery beside the grave of her husband, Samuel Earhart who died in 1938.

**Mrs. Anna Earhart Dies At Douglas**

Mrs. Anna Earhart, born at Boone, Iowa, November 4, 1866, passed away at Douglas, Wyoming December 1, 1950, being just past 84 years old. She leaves to mourn her, one niece, Mrs. Fran M. Mills of Des Moines, Iowa.

She received her education in the school of Boone, and afterward became a teacher in the city schools there for a number of years, until she was united in marriage to Samuel Earhart in 1912. They moved to Cheyenne, where Mr. Earhart was a railway mail clerk. They lived in Cheyenne until 1915, when they moved to their farm near Wheatland. Since Mr. Earhart's passing in 1939 she has continued to live in Wheatland.

Funeral services were held Monday at the Schrader Chapel with Rev. Milstead officiating and burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
