Orval Dennis Earle of Halls Ranch Route, Wheatland, died Tuesday, June 12, 1979 in Cheyenne. Services were held Friday, June 15, 1979, at the First Baptist Church with Rev. Ralph Martin of Rockford, Illinois and Rev. Elton Bleeker officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Serving as pallbearers were Phil Howe, Odie Stevenson, Curtis Ricker, Arthur Parker, Randy Stevenson, Rocky Ralls, and Darrell Rants. Schrader-Prell Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.

Earle was born in Clayton, New Mexico June 16, 1957. A resident here since 1958, he graduated from Wheatland High School in 1975 and attended Casper College for two years. He returned to live at home with his parents while employed by B & W Construction Co. as an office clerk. He was a member of the First Baptist Church.

He is survived by his parents Orval and Thelma Earle of Wheatland; paternal grandfather, Kenneth Earle, Sr. of Clayton, N.M.; maternal grandmother, Leora Parman of Nara Visa, N.M.; a sister, Gayle Ricker and her husband, Tim, of Wheatland; two nephews, Cory and Ryan Ricker of Wheatland.
