Henry L. Earp Dies Here at The Age of Eighty-Seven Years

Henry Langford Earp passed away at his home two miles east of Wheatland Monday, Dec. 30, at the age of 87 years. Although Mr. Earp had not been in the best of health for some time, his death came quite suddenly.

Mr. Earp was born in Bucyrus, Ohio on November 7, 1853. He moved to Wheatland with his family where he has resided for the past eleven years.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Bertha Earp, two sons and six daughters, F.O. Earp of Stockton, Calif., Milton F. Earp of Tacoma, Wash., Mrs. Frank Galloway of Vancouver, Wash., Mrs. H.H. Coulter of Vallejo, Calif., Ethel Earp of Stockton, Calif., Mrs. Arthur Allison of Vallejo, Calif., Mrs. O.G. Brandt of Cheyenne and Mrs. Ida Mae Earp of Wheatland.

Funeral services were conducted at 2:00 this afternoon, Thursday, from the Watson and Dennis chapel with Rev. H.N. Waddell in charge. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
