1884-April 15, 1945

Funeral services were held in the Schrader chapel Wednesday at 2 p.m. for Robert Ekstrom who died Sunday, April 15, following an illness of two weeks. The Rev. C.F. Thomas officiated.

Robert Pere Edwin Ekstrom, 60, was born in Sweden and has been a resident of the Slater community since 1913. His wife, Ethyl, preceded him in death in 1941. He was affiliated with the Baptist church.
