

ESHOM, MAURICE NOBLE, SR.
October 28, 1892-December 17, 1946

Maurice Noble Eshom, 54, died at the Wheatland hospital Tuesday, December 17, following a two weeks stay. He was born in Atchinson, Kansas October 28, 1892, and had been a resident of this community since 1902. He was engaged in farming southwest of Wheatland, and is a veteran of World War I.

He is survived by his wife, Grace; two sons, Maurice, Jr. and George Thomas, both at home; one daughter, Mrs. Vivian Perdue of Wheatland; two brothers, Arthur H.
