Ferd Fabricius dies after short illness

Funeral services are tentatively scheduled for Saturday, June 16, at 2:00 p.m. in the Schrader chapel for Ferdinand Fabricius, who passed away June 12, following a short illness.

Mr. Fabricius was born in Ft. Collins, Colo., October 15, 1905, and had been a farmer in this community for the past 15 years. He came here from Ault, Colo. and was affiliated with the Lutheran church.
