

FANCHER, RUTH MITCHELL
January 12, 1895-November 22, 1966

Ruth M. Fancher, lifetime resident of Wheatland, succumbed in Denver, Colo. on November 22, 1966 after an illness of four months. She was born on January 12, 1895, in Wheatland where she ranched until her death. She was a member of the All Saints Episcopal Church, Laramie River Club, Cow-Belles, and the State Historical Society.
