

# Craig Michael "Bear" Isabell

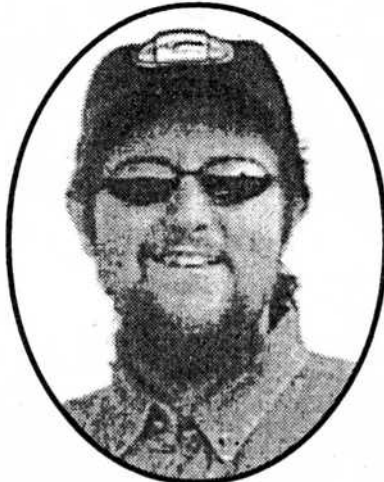
January 21, 1965 - September 20, 2001
