November 12, 1887-January 22, 1981

Ethel Myrah Isabell, 93, died Thursday, Jan. 22, 1981 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Wing.

Ethel, the daughter of Sherman W. and Sarah Armstrong Titus, was born Nov. 12, 1887 in Ogallala, Neb. She was raised and educated in Nebraska and was married to Samuel A. Isabell, May 13, 1903, in St. Deroin, Neb. They moved to the Wheatland area in 1923 to homestead. She was a member of the First Christian Church and was active in WCTU, Eastern Stars and Grandmothers Club.

She is survived by her sons; Sam and Casmer of Wheatland; three daughters, Mrs. Lillian Krewer of Cheyenne, Mrs. Pearl Lawrence of Wheatland, and Mrs. Delores Christensen of Bozeman, Mont.; one brother, Howard Titus of Fall City, Neb.; 19 grandchildren; 34 great grandchildren; 11 great great grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.
