Dies In Denver

Samuel Lee Isabell, age 27, succumbed Wednesday, December 2, 1970 at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Denver, Colo., after an extended illness.

He was born in Wheatland April 21, 1943 and had spent most of his life here. He was a graduate of Wheatland High School and Jr. College in Casper and he attended the University of Denver for two years, where he majored in drafting, graduating last September. He received his diploma for map drafting and technical illustrating. In January 1962, he entered the Navy and received a medical discharge in January 1964.

Mr. Isabell was married to Sharon A. Wiese July 5, 1963 at Las Vegas. He was affiliated with the Christian church.

Survivors include his wife and two sons, Michael and Mark, his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Sam Isabell, Jr., his grandmother, Mrs. Sam Isabell, Sr.; two sisters, Mrs. Beverly (Jack) Carey of Worland and Mrs. Tina Woodfork of Shirley Basin.

Services were held Saturday December 5 at 3:00 p.m. in the First Christian Church, with Rev. Monte D. Shepherd officiating.
