Vehicle Mishap Claims Life of Kay Kahler, 49

Funeral services for Mrs. Kay Marie Kahler (Montgomery) will be held Wednesday, October 15, 1975 at 2:00 p.m. at the First Baptist Church in Wheatland with the Rev. Douglas J. Neumann officiating. Burial will be at the Wheatland Cemetery.

A former Wheatland resident for 15 years, Mrs. Kahler was killed Saturday, October 11, 1975 in an accident involving an all-terrain vehicle in the Laramie Peak area of Albany County.

She was born in Reedsburg, Wisconsin August 17, 1926. She was a member of the Baptist Church here in Wheatland and the American Legion Auxiliary. Just recently having moved from Wheatland, Mrs. Kahler worked as a receptionist at the Kings Inn in Torrington.

In death, she is survived by sons, Steve Kahler of Cheyenne, Phil Kahler and Gary Kahler both of Wheatland, and Tom Kahler of Gillette; one daughter, Delores Shell of Linwood, Kansas; one brother, Don DeVault of Memphis, Tenn.; two sisters, Elaine Barto of Hillsboro, Wisconsin and Donene Haller of Madison, Wisconsin; and six grandchildren.
