Last Rites Wed. For Nancy Keiffer

Last rites for Nancy Jane Keiffer were held Wednesday, Jan. 3, at 1:00 p.m. from the Schrader Chapel. Father Leonard Wren officiated and burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.

The frozen body of Miss Keiffer, who had been missing from her home since Dec. 24, was found by hunters Saturday about six miles north of Wheatland. Date of death was established as Dec. 24. According to County Coroner Ted Schrader, an inquest into the death is pending an outcome of the autopsy report.

Nancy Keiffer was born August 8, 1944 at Wheatland and was a graduate of the Wheatland schools. She had been employed the past five years at the Welfare office. She was affiliated with the Catholic church.

Survivors include her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Fred Keiffer; two brothers, Ernest J. and Pat Keiffer, both of Casper and one sister, Mrs. Rose Cruz of Casper.
