

KENNEDY, ARTHUR LEWIS  
November 28, 1900-July 7, 1971

Arthur Lewis Kennedy, 70, died following an extended illness, Friday, July 7, 1971 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital.

Born in Berthoud, Colo. Nov. 28, 1900, he married Katherine Schimidt Sept. 3, 1921, and was employed at a mechanic for Walton Motor in Cheyenne for 35 years. He had been a resident of Wheatland for the past 17 years and was employed by the Wheatland Motor Co. for 14 years.

Besides affiliation with the Methodist Church, Mr. Kennedy was a member of AF & AM No.16 and a charter member of AF & AM Gem City No. 52. He was a past High Priest of the Royal Arch Mason and a Past Commander of Knights Templar.

The deceased is survived by his wife, Katherine, and two daughters, Mrs. Delbert Hardin, Laramie and Mrs. Ben Cripps, Cheyenne. Also surviving are five grandchildren and two great grandchildren.

Services were held by the Masonic Lodge at the Schrader Chapel on Tuesday, July 13, 1971 at 10:30 a.m. with burial at the Wheatland cemetery. Pallbearers were members of the Masonic Lodge.
