

## Albert Kincaid Is Buried Saturday

Albert Leroy Kincaid, age 76, passed away Tuesday, March 15, 1977 at the V.A. Hospital in Sheridan after an extended illness. Services were held

Saturday, March 19, 1977 at the Schrader-Prell Chapel in Wheatland with Rev. Dan Barcus officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Kincaid was born in South Dakota June 15, 1901. He lived in the Wheatland area since shortly after his birth. He served in the Air Force during WWII, after which time he was employed as a farm and ranch hand until he was taken ill.

In death he is survived by his brother, James Kincaid, of Lincoln, Ark., and his sisters, Ann Shuster of Kansas City, Mo., Martha Phillips of Lincoln, Ark., Ruth Simmons of Simon, Calif., and Edith Knowles of San Diego, Calif.
