

KING, WAYNE ROBERT
November 9, 1914-October 17, 1978

Wayne King, 63, a lifetime resident of Platte County, died Tuesday, Oct. 17 at the Veteran's Hospital in Denver, Colo.

King was born in Wheatland on Nov. 9, 1914, the son of Walter and Elizabeth James King. He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II as an aviation machinist's mate. Following the war, he returned to Wheatland and ranched east of Wheatland until his death.

He is survived by his mother, Elizabeth King of Wheatland. He was preceded in death by his father, Walter King, who died in April of 1976, and a sister, Evelyn King.

Funeral services were conducted at the Schrader-Prell Chapel on Friday, Oct. 20 at 10 a.m. with Rev. Charles Clough officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
