Funeral services for Hazel K. Klein, 83, will be held Tuesday, February 17, 2004 at 2:00 P.M. at the Wheatland Bible Church with Pastor Denzil G. Mauk officiating. Inurnment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Klein died Thursday, February 12, 2004 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland, Wyoming.

their deaths. She enjoyed gardening, sewing, quilting, and spending time with her family.

She is survived by her children, Laura Banta of Denver, Colorado and Dale Klein of Wheatland; daughters-in-law, Judy Klein and Charlotte Klein both of Wheatland; son-in-law, Michael Banta of Denver; sisters, Ella Burzlaff and Leslie Juschka both of Wheatland; six grandsons; one granddaughter; and eight great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her father, Martin, on December 10, 1967; her mother, Laura, on May 9, 1964; her husband, Bill, on June 7, 1998; her son, Troy Martin Klein, on January 18, 1999; her brothers, Alvin Jessen and Glenn Jessen; and her sisters, Mabel Miller and Elizabeth Bohl.
