

KNUDSON, ELIZA HANNAH BASSFORD

November 25, 1862-June 6, 1954

A ninety-one year old woman, Mrs. Eliza Hannah Knudson, died at a local rest home Sunday, after an extended illness. She was the mother of Mrs. Otto Plaga of Wheatland, and had made her home here for the past thirteen years. Another daughter, Mrs. V.W. Strandell of Milwaukee, Wisc., survives, and three sons, George A. Bassford of Ashland, Wisc., the Rev. Porter C. Knudson of Soledad, Calif. and John W. Knudson of Stratten Island, N.Y. Also listed among her survivors are nine grandchildren and five great grandchildren.

Funeral services were held at the Schrader's chapel Wednesday afternoon at 2:00 with Rev. J.B. Milstead officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery, and Dick Pulver, Bob Daly, John Merbach, Doyle Hutchinson, George Waln and Lowell Clark were pallbearers.

Mrs. Knudson was a Gold Star mother, and as such, made a pilgrimage to Europe in 1932. She was born in Milwaukee, Wisc. November 25, 1862 and was a member of the Morovian church.
