Jack Larson, 47, died at the Veterans' hospital in Cheyenne Sunday after being stricken with pneumonia four days previously. Mr. Larson was a blacksmith by trade, and had made his home in Wheatland for some time. He was born in Knox, Ind.

He is survived by his wife, Jane, a daughter, Mrs. Nadine Leach of Dallas, Tex., a son, Robert of Cheyenne, a step-son, Davie Cook of Wheatland, his father, Andrew Larson, living in Kansas, a brother, Oscar Larson of Wheatland and six sisters.

Funeral services were conducted Wednesday afternoon from the Watson-Dennis funeral home, with the Rev. Harry Allen officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery where the American Legion were in charge of the military graveside services.
