

LAWRENCE, OSCAR B.
March 7, 1871-May 5, 1925

Oscar B. Lawrence died suddenly on Tuesday morning at his home on the former Boggs farm west of Wheatland after an illness of only a few hours.

Mr. Lawrence worked on his hay baler on the morning of the previous day, and had attended the Harris-Smith sale that afternoon. That evening he was seized with an acute pain in his side, and medical aid was summoned. He was apparently relieved, but was again seized early in the morning, and died about 3 a.m.

He was born in Richland, Nebr. in March 7, 1871, growing to manhood at that place. He was married to Ella L. Church, on Dec. 24, 1894, at Schuyler, Nebr. Seven children were born to them, of whom six are now living, as follows: Cloyd Lawrence of Wheatland; Mrs. Mabel Kuhns of Manville; Ben B. Lawrence, Edward Lawrence, Fern Lawrence and Harry Lawrence, all of Wheatland. He moved with his family to this vicinity seven years ago.

The funeral will be held from the Methodist church at 2:30 P.M. Friday.
