

LEWIS, OLGA MARIE
October 13, 1894-February 4, 1966

Olga Marie Lewis, a resident of this area for the past 50 years, succumbed suddenly Feb. 4, 1966 at her home 16 miles south of Wheatland. Mrs. Lewis was born in Carbon County, Wyoming, Oct. 13, 1894. She was married to Claude Lewis at Rawlins in 1913.

The Lewis' homesteaded on a ranch in the Elk Mountain area. They later ranched in the Laramie Peak country, on the Sybille, Tie Siding, the Reider ranch on the Snake River, the Shaw ranch (former Gerald Wilkerson estate) and the present location on the CMD ranch.

Mrs. Lewis, who was a member of the Christian church, is survived by her husband, Claude, and a brother, Fred Filpula, of Willits, Calif.

Services were conducted by Mr. Dale Scheffler at the Schrader Chapel on Feb. 7 at 11:00 a.m. with interment in the Wheatland cemetery. Serving as pallbearers were Jack Finnerty, Robert Grant, Bud Wilson, Harry Coleman, Ed Kendig and Duncan Wiebel.
