

6-20 MARGARET PICKERILL LOCKE 1984
Graveside services for Margaret Pickerill Locke, 83, who died in Rawlins, June 20, were held Saturday, June 23, in the Wheatland Cemetery with Dan Barcus officiating.

Born in Bridgeport, Neb., May 23, 1901, Margaret Locke was the daughter of William and Maggie Pickerill. She came to the Wheatland area to homestead in Palmer Canyon with her family when she was a young girl.

She married Charles Frederick Locke and the couple took a homestead at the foot of Laramie Peak. They moved to Wheatland in 1944 where she spent her remaining years until ill health caused her to be hospitalized in Rawlins for the past three years.

Survivors include a son, Donald Locke of Mitchell, Neb., a brother Robert Pickerill of Wheatland, two sisters: Mona Gedra of Cheyenne, Irene Gillman of California and four grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents, 1 husband, a son, two daughters, and a brother.
