Funeral Tuesday For Mrs. Lockman

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon at 3 o'clock in the Methodist church for Mrs. Mollie Lockman, 23, who died at the Wheatland hospital February 2 following a three weeks' illness, with the Rev. William Borneman of Torrington officiating. Mrs. Lockman was born August 15, 1923 at Windsor, Colo., and came to this community with her parents in 1929. Prior to her death she had lived 3 miles west of Wheatland. She was a member of the Trinity Lutheran church.

She is survived by her husband, Walter D. Lockman; 2 sons, Richard Walter and Johnny Lee; her parents, Mr. and Mrs. William Eichler; six sisters, Mrs. John Dignes and Mrs. Henry Geringer of Wheatland, Mrs. Paul Frihauf, Wiggins, Colo., Mrs. Ben Lockman, Wheatland, Helen and Leona Eichler at home. A son and daughter preceded her in death; also one brother who died in the service, two sisters and another brother.
