**Charles R. Trenholm, Former Resident, is Called by Death**

**Body Interred Tuesday in Wheatland Cemetery**

At the age of 59 years, Dr. Charles R. Trenholm, former Wheatland resident, was called to his final reward at his home at Lyman, Nebr., at an early hour Sunday morning, a victim of acute nephritis.

Doctor Trenholm was a dental surgeon and some twenty-two years ago followed his profession in Wheatland.

When word of his death reached Wheatland, relatives went to the Nebraska town, and made arrangements for the bringing of the body to this place for burial. Funeral services were held at the M.E. church Tuesday morning at ten o'clock, conducted by Rev. Orman King. Interment being made by the Watson Mortuary.

Charles Robert Trenholm was born in Richmond, Canada, October 21, 1872 and passed away at Lyman, Nebr., November 10th, 1929. He received his early schooling in Richmond, later entering the dental college at Philadelphia. After graduating he came to Wheatland, where he practiced dentistry for two years. He then moved to Elmwood, Nebr., where he continued his profession until recently. He was married to Dorothy Jesse of Wheatland, October 14, 1902. He is survived by his wife, two sons, Raymond and Charles and one daughter, Marjory; also one brother, F.H. Trenholm of Wheatland; and two sisters, Mrs. T.L. Lane, of Vancouver, British Columbia, and Mrs. H.D. Brown, Toronto, Canada.

**DR. TRENHOLM DIES**

Dr. C.R. Trenholm, who conducted a dental parlor at Wheatland some 33 years ago, died at Lyman, Nebr., on Sunday. The body was shipped to Wheatland for burial, funeral services being held from the Watson Mortuary on Monday forenoon at 10:30 o'clock. The funeral was attended by many of the old time friends of the deceased, who knew him in the pioneer days of the town.

Charles Robert Trenholm was born in Richmond, Canada, Providence of Quebec, on October 21, 1872, and passed away at Lyman, Nebr., November 10, 1929.
