

UNKNOWN INFANT GIRL

?-June 19, 1916

The body of a new born baby girl was found Monday evening floating on the water of No. 2 canal near the 9th St. bridge. Arthur Rugg's children made the discovery and called passers. Sheriff Roach was notified and the corpse was taken to the Christensen undertaking rooms. Coroner Corry was called from Chugwater and with the local officers spent the day trying to find evidence that would lead to the discovery of the perpetrator of the crime, but without results up to last night.

The child was fully developed and bore evidence from drowning. Investigations are still in progress, and if the parties who committed the deed can be apprehended, they will be prosecuted for murder.
