Alan Lee Utter, 57, passed away at his home of Wheatland Friday, February 20, 1998.

Alan was born September 2, 1940 to Emerson and Ruth (Cochran) Utter in Wheatland. He attended Wheatland schools graduating in 1959. He began his college education at Eastern Wyoming College in Torrington and graduated from the University of Wyoming in 1965.

He married Sharon Flock at Lingle on January 31, 1965. Their farm included a cattle and hog operation west of Wheatland. He was a member of the Laramie Peak Stockgrowers and served on the Wheatland Irrigation District Board of Directors. Alan was a 4-H leader and enjoyed helping young people. He was chosen outstanding cooperator of the Platte County Resource District in 1988.

A private memorial service was held at the farm February 23.

Survivors are his wife; a daughter and son-in-law, Sandra and Todd Milton of Walton, Nebraska; a son, Wade of Cheyenne; two brothers, Dennis of Kenesaw, Nebraska and Brian of Milford, Nebraska; two half-sisters, Chloe Jones of Laramie and Bonnie Shaffer of Las Vegas, Nevada and a half-brother, Kevin of Fort Collins, Colorado; a step-grandmother, Hattie Utter of Wheatland; two aunts, Glyda May and Ruby Wickam, both of Wheatland and numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and half-brother, Lynn.
