

VAUDREY, JAMES T.
December 2, 1913-July 22, 1973

Funeral services were held Wednesday, July 25, at 10:00 a.m. for James T. Vaudrey, 59, Wheatland, at the First Christian Church with the Reverend Daniel Barcus officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery. Charles Parsons, William Lebsack, Ned Wedemeyer, Everett Waln, Harold Nagel and Robert Harman served as pallbearers.
