

VERMILYEA, FOREST HAMPTON

August 8, 1900-June 16, 1986

Services for Forest Hampton "Tot" Vermilyea, 85, who died in Wheatland, June 16, 1986 were held Friday, June 20, at 10:30 a.m. in the First Christian Church in Wheatland with Chet Shaw minister.

Born in Colfax, Iowa, Aug. 8, 1900 Forest Vermilyea was the son of Joseph and Florence (Downing) Vermilyea. In 1915 he came to Wyoming where he held various mining and farming jobs.

He and Erma Rutherford were married in November of 1938. He was an avid fisherman, bowler and sports fan.
