

Bessie Corina Vigil

Services for Bessie Corina Vigil, 72, who died in Wheatland, May 18, 1987, were held at 11:00 a.m. today in St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Wheatland with Father Malcolm Reid officiating. A rosary service was held in the Church Tuesday evening at 7:00.

Bessie Vigil was born in Mora, N.M., July 1, 1914, the daughter of Dominico and Juanita (Garcia) Vigil. She attended school and spent her childhood in New Mexico.
