

WARREN, DEAN
March 24, 1916-April 12, 1952

Dean Warren, 36, died in Ray, Colo. April 12, following a brief illness. He was the son of Mrs. Dollie Warren.

Mr. Warren was born at Slater March 24, 1916. He was a veteran of World War II and holder of the purple heart and combat infantry man badge. He had been employed as a painter for Harry Dearing for several years.

Funeral services were held in Ray Tuesday afternoon. Schraders brought the body to Wheatland Wednesday for services which were held today (Thursday) at 2 o'clock with military honors at the graveside. Burial was made in Wheatland.
