

WEST, LETITIA SARAH JONES
March 9, 1900-August 23, 1975

Mrs. Letitia West passed away Saturday, August 23, 1975, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital after a brief illness. Mrs. West, 75, had been a resident of Wheatland for 42 years.

Funeral services were held today, August 27, 1975, at 11:00 a.m. at the Nazarene Church with Rev. Edward Haldy officiating. Interment was at the Wheatland Cemetery.
