

### **Elizabeth Wilhelm**

A private memorial service was Sunday, Jan. 11, in Portland, Ore., for Elizabeth Wilhelm, 84, Portland, who died there Thursday, Jan. 8.

She was born Aug. 29, 1902, to Frank and Katherine (Wilhelm) Wilhelm in Sugar City.

She married Alex Wilhelm in Denver.

Mrs. Wilhelm came to Greeley with her parents in 1903, attending school here. After her marriage, the couple moved to Wheatland, Wyo., where they farmed. Her husband died in 1950. She returned to Greeley in 1954, and worked at North Colorado Medical Center until retiring at the age of 65. In October 1984, she moved to Portland to be near her daughter.

While living in Greeley, she was a member of St. Paul's Congregational church and St. Paul's Ladies Aid.

Survivors are a daughter, Mrs. Dale (Ruth) Holcomb of Portland; a son, Robert of Denver; two sisters, Hilda Edwards of Eaton, and Leia Wagner of Longmont; and two grandchildren. Two children and a grandchild are deceased.

Interment will be in Wheatland Wyoming.
