Paul A. Williams Succumbs May 14

Paul A. Williams was born May 5, 1887 in Farmers, Ind., and passed away in Platte County Memorial Hospital, Wheatland, May 14, 1961 at the age of 74. He was a retired railroad carman, having worked for the Union Pacific for 10 years. Mr. Williams homesteaded in the Big Horn Basin in 1918, living in Laramie 12½ years and in Wheatland for the past five years.

He was affiliated with the Methodist church, being a charter member in Denver, Colo. and in Wyoming. He also had been a member of the Odd Fellows Lodge for 52 years.

Rev. Robert French conducted funeral services from the Methodist church, Wheatland at 2:00 p.m. Wednesday. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery with IOOF graveside services, and members of the lodge acting as pallbearers.
