**MISS ANNA YATES OF UVA DIES MONDAY AFTER LONG ILLNESS**

Anna V. Yates, long time resident of Uva, passed away in Wheatland Monday after an illness of some time. Her condition had become critical shortly before the first of the year but her friends were shocked over her death.

Funeral services are being held from the Episcopal church this afternoon at 2 o'clock with Rev. W. Hewton Ward of Douglas officiating. Interment took place in the Wheatland cemetery with the Lyla Watson Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
