Jesse F. Yates succumbs in New Mexico at 87

Last rites for Jesse F. Yates, retired farmer, were held at the Schrader Chapel on Jan. 24, 1966 at 2:00 p.m. with Rev. Irvin Noyce officiating. Interment was in the local cemetery. Soloist for the service was Mrs. Henry Therkildsen of Casper, who was accompanied on the organ by Mrs. Bruce von Forrell.

Mr. Yates was born in Tama, Ia. on July 11, 1878, and succumbed at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Richard Amerman, in Farmington, New Mex. on Jan. 20 after a brief illness. The deceased was married to Dora Sires in September, 1911 at Stanton, Nebr. Before moving to the Wheatland area in 1920, they resided in Iowa.

Surviving relatives are his daughter Mrs. Amerman, a son John C. Yates of Laramie and 9 grandchildren. His wife preceded him in death in 1921. Mr. Yates was the last member of his family of eleven.
