

YOST, DONALD C.
December 15, 1927-July 27, 1950

Funeral services for Don C. Yost, 22 year old son of Mr. and Mrs. William M. Yost of Wheatland were held Sunday at 2:00 p.m. at the Congregational church with Mr. W.M. Kruse and Rev. W. James Hoare officiating.

Don died July 27 at the St. John's hospital in Jackson, Wyo. following a car accident July 23. The only other occupant in the car at the time of the accident was his wife, Mrs. Alice Yost, who escaped uninjured. The accident occurred six miles north of Jackson.

Don was born December. 15, 1927 and came to Wheatland with his parents in 1928 where he had lived most of his life. He was a member of the American Legion, V.F.W., Moose Lodge and was a graduate of Wheatland high school with the class of 1945. He served with the U.S. Navy in World War II.

At the time of his death, Yost was a road contractor foreman employed by James Orr of Casper.

He is survived by his wife, Alice Yost of Casper, Mr. and Mrs. William M. Yost of Wheatland; four brothers, Clyde of Eckla, Mont., Raymond of Wheatland, Dale of Pennsacola, Fla., Robert of San Francisco, and a sister, Mrs. Margret Fieth of Boulder, Colo.; his grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Lou Graham of Wheatland.
