Funeral Services Held Today For Mrs. Zimmerman

Funeral services were held today (Thursday) for Mrs. Anna S. Zimmerman, 81, who passed away at the Platte County Memorial Hospital on Monday, June 23, following a brief illness. Rev. J.B. Milstead officiated at the services conducted from the Schrader chapel with burial in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mrs. Zimmerman was born on June 1, 1877 in Lagersville, Ohio and was postmistress at Romona, Kans. for 14 years and taught various schools in Kansas prior to her retirement. In 1945 she moved to Wheatland and had made her home with her sister, Mrs. M.C. Logan since that time. She was a member of the Presbyterian church.

Survivors besides Mrs. Logan include one other sister, Mrs. Bertha Connelly, Romona, Kans. and one brother, Frank Lemley, of Atlantic City. Her husband preceded her in death in 1944.

Pallbearers were George Woolsey, Leonard Weber, Denzil Blow, Chris Franzen, Leo Norris and Virgil Vogt.

Last Rites Held For Anna Zimmerman

Anna S. Zimmerman was born June 1, 1877 in Lagersville, Ohio, and passed away at the Platte County Memorial Hospital, June 23, 1958. She was 81 years of age at the time of her death.

Mrs. Zimmerman has made her home here since 1945 and for the past 13 years with her sister, Mrs. M.C. Logan. She was a retired postmistress and school teacher, having been postmistress at Romona, Kans., for 14 years, and taught in various schools in Kansas. She was affiliated with the Presbyterian church.

Funeral services were conducted from the Schrader chapel, Thursday at 2:00 p.m. with Rev. J.B. Milstead officiating. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery with pallbearers being George Woolsey, Leonard Weber, Denzil Blow, Chris Franzen, Leo Norris and Virgil Vogt.
